

The Law of Exchange

How does the Law of Exchange affect our lives?

1. We “.....” Jesus our sins: (1John 1:9) (Matthew 11:29-30.)
The **Exchange**: - He gave us His “.....” (2 Corinthians 5:21)
2. We give Jesus our old self: (Matthew 11:28)
The **Exchange**: - He gives us “.....” (Romans 6:4.)
3. Peter gave his boat for a pulpit: (Luke 5:3-4.)
The **Exchange**: - Jesus gave it back filled with fish. (Luke 5:4-6.)
4. The little boy gave five loaves and two fish: (John 6:9-13.)
The **Exchange**: - Jesus fed the five thousand. (John 9: 13-17.)
5. The flowers of today are the seeds of yesterday – is our garden of tomorrow.
6. Whatever God plants He will also cause to “grow.”

The law of exchange can also be called the law of sowing and reaping

Jesus has redeemed us from the curse of the Law, being made a curse for us

Galatians 3:13-14: for it is written, “cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree” in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come on the gentiles, so that we might receive the promise of the Holy Spirit through faith. (Ref: NAS Bible.)

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5. It is God who gives man the authority to get wealth.

Joshua 1:8: *“This book of the law (The Word of God) shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.”*

2Corinthians 8:9: *“You know how full of love and kindness our Lord Jesus was. Though He was so very rich, yet to help you He became so very poor, so that by being poor He could make you rich.”*

Understanding God’s prosperity

1. To have God’s prosperity we must first settle the question of His “Lordship over our lives.”
2. Recognise that you live in **“the world”** Greek translated **“Cosmos,”** a system of society that is self-centred, and which is manipulated by Satan. Unsaved people without Jesus inevitably have a selfish motivation, which is the devil’s motivation. “What I can get out of this.” – “I will become as God” has always been the root sin.

If Jesus is 100% Lord, then He is not only Lord of our spiritual life, but also of our physical and that includes our finances.

Many will say money is an unspiritual subject. Jesus spoke more of money than heaven and hell. Why? He knew that where a man’s money is, there will his heart also be. (Matthew 6:21)

Does any part of my possessions belong to God?

1. The “.....” and “.....” and “.....” to the poor, is every Christian’s responsibility.
2. Men have “.....” in their “.....”

Malachi 3:8: “Begin by being honest. Do honest people rob God? But you rob me day after day.” You ask, “How have we robbed you?” “The tithe and the offering -- that’s how!” (Ref: Message Bible.)

Malachi 3:10: “Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so that there will be food enough in my temple; if you do, I will open the windows of heaven for you and pour out a blessing so great you won’t have enough room to take it in!” (Ref: Living Bible Edition.)
